

AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH COUNCIL LAUNCHES ITS FIRST NIETVOORBIJ GIN JUST IN TIME FOR SUMMER

The Agricultural Research Council (ARC) has added a gin to its Nietvoorbij range, giving consumers something delightful to sip on this summer.

The gin was launched at the ARC's Nietvoorbij campus on Friday, 18 November 2022. Distilled from Hanepoot wine then infused with juniper berries, the gin has floral muscat flavours with notes of lavender and orange peel. No other botanicals were added to ensure that the natural aromatic wine cultivar was highlighted.

Winemakers, Craig Paulsen and Maxine Newman embarked on a gin journey earlier this year to develop a product that expands on the current wine range, opening the brand to a diverse audience. The reimagined Nietvoorbij brand, launched in 2019, tells a story of growth, transformation, and the freedom to explore and soar in the wine industry.
