

SPIDERS IN AND AROUND THE HOUSE

FREE-LIVING



Flatties (*Selenops radiatus*) are commonly found in houses on walls



Rain spiders (*Palystes superciliosus*) are common in houses during rainy spells



Sac spiders (*Cheiracanthium furculatum*) are commonly found in houses in material folds



Violin spiders (*Loxosceles* sp.) are sometimes found in houses in dark areas



Jumping spiders (*Hasarius adansonii*) are very common in houses



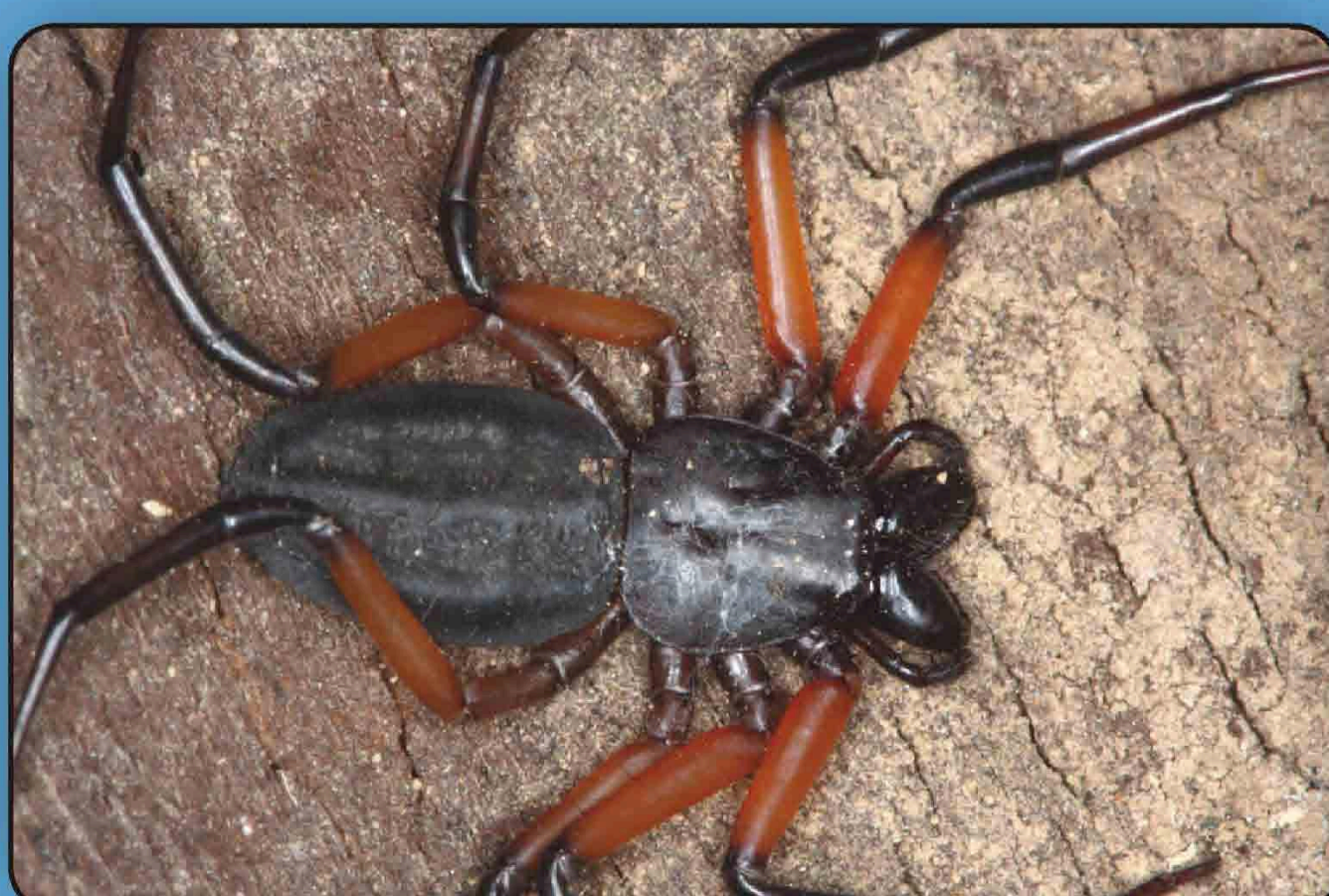
Spitting spiders (*Scytodes* sp.) are very common in cupboards in houses



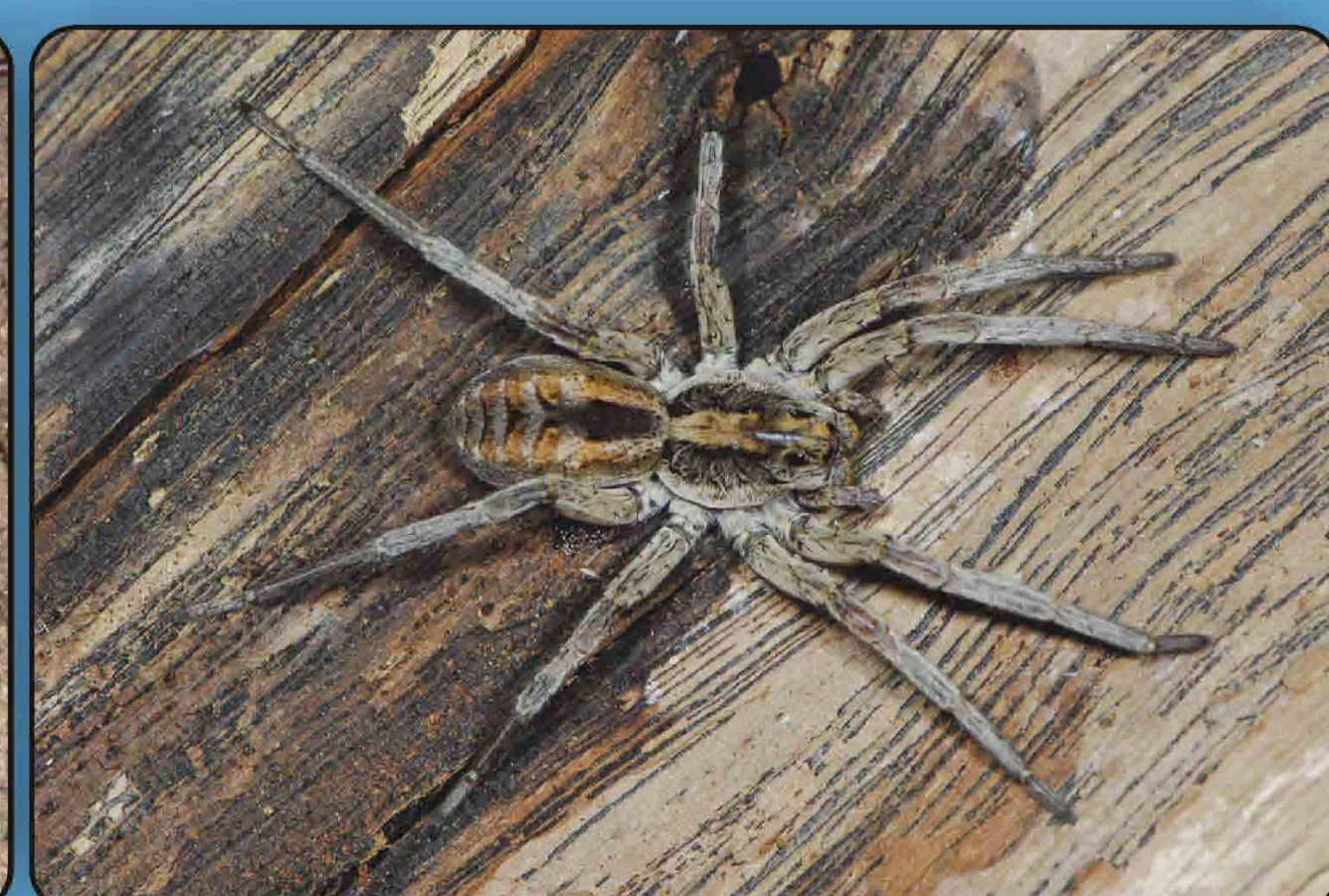
Nursery-web spiders (*Rothus* sp.) are sometimes found in houses but are more common on plants



Crab-spiders (*Thomisus* sp.) are very common on flowers



Scorpion spiders (*Platyoides walteri*) are sometimes found under pot plants



Wolf spiders (*Hogna* sp.) are common in gardens and sometimes wander into houses

WEB DWELLERS



Black button spiders (*Latrodectus renivulvatus*) are sometimes found around houses



Brown button spiders (*Latrodectus geometricus*) are common around houses



False button spiders (*Theridion purcelli*) are common in and around houses



Feather-legged spiders (*Uloborus plumipes*) are common around houses and live in orb-webs



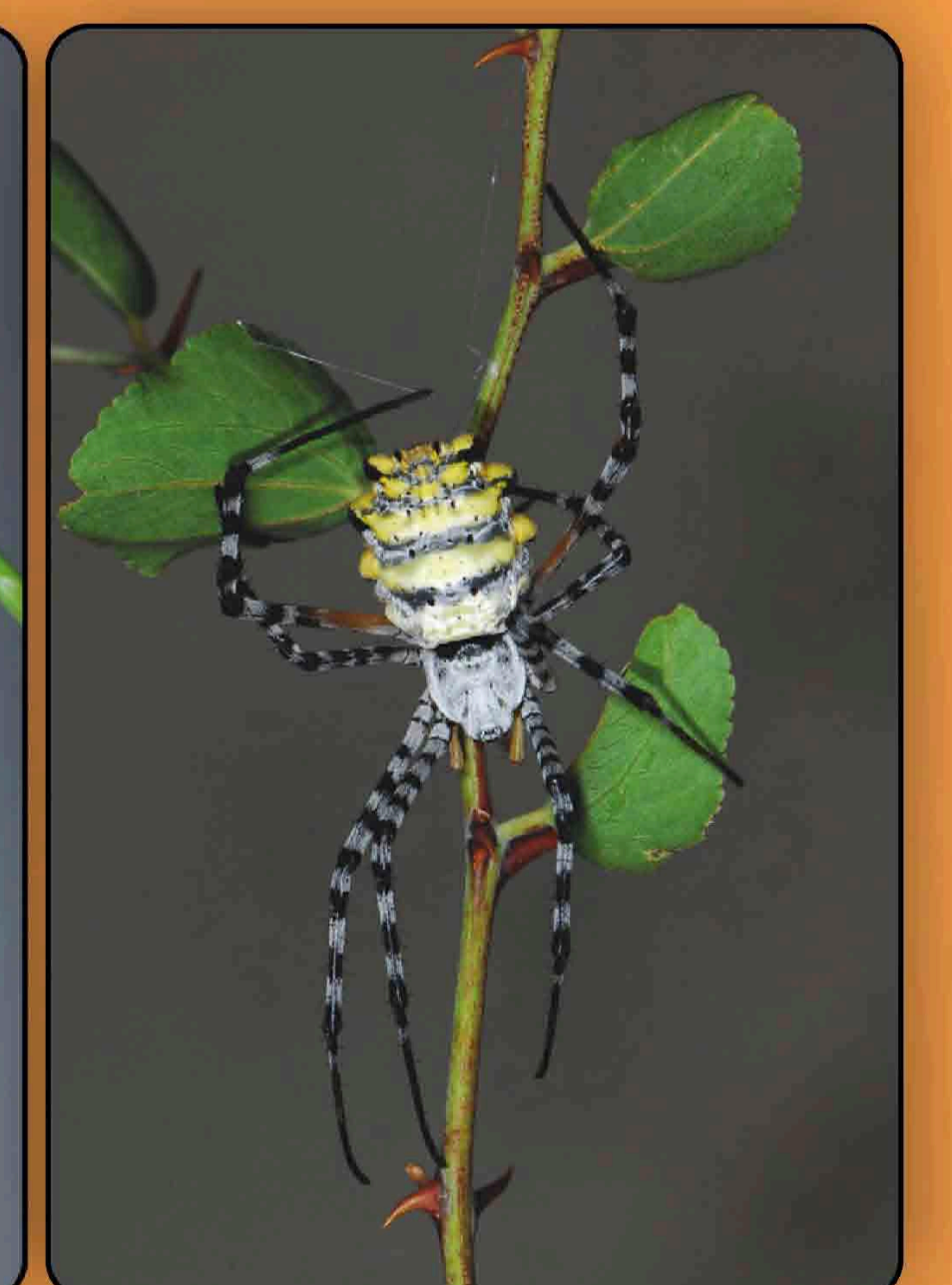
Daddy long legs spiders (*Smeringopus natalensis*) are very common in and around houses and live in space webs



Hairy field spiders (*Neoscona* spp.) are common around houses and found in orb-webs at night



Garden orb-web spiders (*Argiope* spp.) are common around houses and found in orb-webs



Ant eating spiders (*Oecobius navus*) are common on walls and live under small retreat webs
